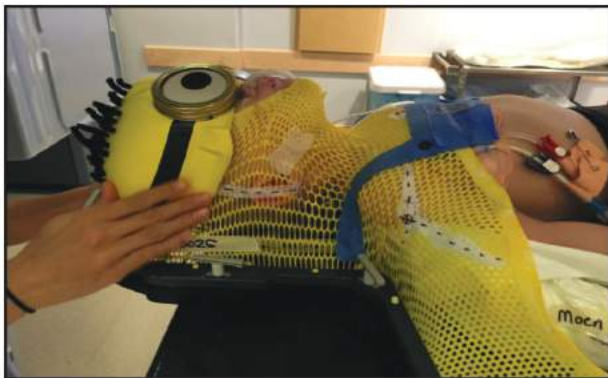


Kaylee's Hero Fund Main Purpose

Examples of Financial Strain Families Face Who Have a Child With Cancer

- **Loss of Income** - One parent must stay with the child throughout their hospital stay which will result in loss of income.
- **Travel Costs** - Transportation costs are a significant challenge for families that have to travel from outside the Lower Mainland.
- **Child Care** - Families have to provide child care for siblings at home while one parent is at the hospital with their sick child.
- **Food** - Children with cancer experience difficulties with their taste buds and most times require numerous meals made to satisfy their taste.
- **Medication** - Only some medications are covered through pharmacare or BC medical.

- **Accommodations** - Families that travel from outside of the Lower Mainland need to provide a place to stay for their families.
- **Treatment Outside of Canada** - Some children face the prospect of receiving cancer therapy in the United States or outside of the country. The cost for accommodations is expensive and sometimes prohibitive.



Childhood Cancer: The Numbers

- Cancer is the number one disease related killer of Canadian children.
- 1700 children are diagnosed each year in Canada.
- 1 in 5 will not survive their diagnosis.
- 1 in 3 will not live out a normal lifespan.
- 95% of survivors will have chronic health problems.
- Only 3% of government cancer research dollars to childhood cancer.
- Only 2 drugs approved for the treatment of childhood cancers in the past 20 years.
